To All Our Supporters In Greater Cincinnati

SPCA Cincinnati would like to make you aware of a transition that has occurred regarding the Hamilton County Dog Warden's office. Our Organization was contracted by Hamilton County to perform the statutory duties of the Dog Warden for the past 65 years.

In 2019 we determined these duties were no longer in alignment with our overall mission and objectives. At that time we notified Hamilton County that we would be retiring from these duties and would work with them to make a smooth transition to another service provider. We are pleased to announce that this transition has taken place as of July 30, 2020.

SPCA remains your local Humane Society as we have since 1873. Our Sharonville full service kennels and our Miamitown (Simmonds Farm) will continue the existing operations with expanded educational programs and adoption activities.

There will no longer be any SPCA operations at Colerain Avenue.

We remain committed to the humane treatment of all animals and will cooperate fully with Hamilton County and the new Dog Wardens office. It is in everyone's best interest that the same humane care and love we provided to these animals during our many years as Dog Warden, be continued with by the new Organization.

During the past several years, the SPCA Cincinnati provided leadership in creating a collaborative spirit among all animal welfare organizations. In 2018 The Pet Coalition of Greater Cincinnati was formed. The PCGC has actively been engaged in efforts to assist low-income communities with the care and managements of their pets. These activities are congruent with our prior collaboration with UCAN and OAR establishing a low cost spay/neuter trap and release program for community cats.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES NEWS

Adoption Numbers: In the last week, we have had 62 adoptions (43 cats, 17 dogs, and 2 small animals). Numbers will be smaller now that we are only operating out of Sharonville!

Sharonville Opportunities: Now that the shift is complete, we just want to go over the opportunities available at Sharonville. See below for a list of volunteer roles:

Dog Walking Teams, Dog Socialization (Additional training needed), Cat Center Attendant, Kitten Nursery (Additional training needed), Animal Care Assistant – cleaning, Volunteer Services Assistant, Many, many more!

If you are interested in a role, or have an idea for a brand new role, please let me know!

Dog and Cat Socialization Clipboards: In order to keep track of which animals have been worked with, we have hung clipboards in Kennels 1 - 4 as well as in the cat center. When you work with an animal, please record it on the paper so that other volunteers know which animals still need one-on-one time.

Personality Sheets: All animals need a bio so that they can find their forever home. While we try to get to know each animal, it can be difficult to find the time. So, to make things easier, we have hung up personality sheets in the volunteer room (with the Volgistics computer and volunteer aprons). Once you complete a sheet (there are some for both dogs and cats), please hang it on the "Completed Personality Sheets" clipboard. From there, we will be able to create better bios for our shelter residents.

Cat Promo: On August 15th, we will be having an event to hopefully find homes for all of the cats we have at the shelter. From 12-5, we will be opening the shelter up to the public (regulated of course), and adopting cats out for \$5. And we need your help! We need some assistance with adopters to the Cat Center, answering questions, and also need some friendly faces greeting guests and pointing them in the right direction. Sign up on Volgistics today!

Fur Ball Set-Up Help: From 12pm – 2pm on August 19th, we are asking for some additional help with setting up for our virtual silent auction. If you have time, feel free to stop by and help us set up the training room! Shifts are available on Volgistics, but sign-up isn't needed to help with this.

Fur Ball Help: While the Fur Ball is virtual this year, we still need help with the silent auctions items. You can see the shifts on Volgistics: August 30th, September 2nd and September 12th. Please be aware that there is some physical involvement in this as it is a curb-side pickup as a runner, but less physical work involved with check-out.
